**Professor Ted Maddess** has been appointed **Fellow of the National Academy of Inventors**. Ted Maddess, Ph.D., is Professor at the Australian National University. Professor Maddess is the inventor of various commercialised ophthalmic technologies including: *the FDT and Matrix visual field tests*, crucial in the early diagnosis of glaucoma. Professor Maddess previously received the 2002 Clunies Ross Award, Australia's highest award for applied research.

**Professor Jan Provis**: has been made a **Fellow** of the **National Vision Research Institute (2019)**. This award, granted by the National Vision Institute, a division of the Australian College of Optometry, was created to recognise exceptional researchers who have made a significant contribution to the practice and profession of vision science and research.

Professor Maddess has been Chairman of Eye Co's SAB for the last 5 years and his term in that role comes to an end in June 2019. The Board of Eye Co expresses its sincere thanks for his significant contribution to the development of Eye Co's IP portfolio during his tenure. Professor Maddess will remain on the SAB.
